The Clewer Initiative states:

More than 200 years after the abolition of slavery there are still an estimated 45.8 million men, women and children trapped in modern slavery, up to 11,700 potential victims in the UK alone.

We believe that the tools to end modern slavery already exist within the local community and that the Church, which is present in all communities and at the heart of many, has a primary responsibility in leading these efforts.

The Clewer Initiative is a three year project to enable Church of England dioceses and wider Church networks to develop strategies to detect modern slavery in their communities and help provide victim support and care.
